In order to enter students in the Federation Festival in February you must establish a "junior club" to which your students would belong. You may download an application from [ffmc-music.org](http://ffmc-music.org). Select a Junior Club name for your club. You are the Junior Counselor. The Festival Area is Capital District (Choctaw Bay Area). Send the form and check to Shirley Clark, the address and other instructions are on the form. Junior Clubs dues are due September 1, 2006 and must be postmarked by December 1, 2006. If you need a Festival Bulletin you may order if from NFMC, see web site under Publications, Junior Division, item JR-2-1. Cost is \$6.00 plus shipping.
